HOW DO I CLEAN MY SHOWERDOME?

Use a feather duster on the top, and micro-fibre cloth inside, annually, or as required. You can wash your Showerdome with a mild non abrasive detergent and polish with Pledge if you wish.

I HAVE A GAP AROUND THE SHOWER DOOR, DOES IT HAVE TO BE COMPLETELY SEALED FOR THE SHOWERDOME TO WORK?

A small gap does not normally hinder Showerdomes effectiveness. However, if when tested, there is steam coming out of the shower, those gaps will need to be closed by fitting a flexible clear door seal. Your Showerdome dealer usually stocks a range of these.

WHAT IS THE EXPECTED LIFETIME OF MY SHOWERDOME?

Showerdome is guaranteed to remain crystal clear for 30 years, so you can safely expect it to last the lifetime of your shower.

WHERE DOES ALL THE STEAM GO?

There is no steam created when your Showerdome is fitted correctly.

DO I LEAVE THE SHOWER DOOR OPEN OR CLOSED AFTER I FINISH SHOWERING?

At the completion of your shower, step out and close the shower door for approximately 5 mins. When you are about to leave the bathroom, open the door and leave it ajar, and the walls and shower will quickly dry out.

It is important that this procedure is followed to minimize mould or mildew forming inside your shower cubicle.

MY SON IS OVER 2m TALL SO WE WON'T BE ABLE TO STAND UP – ARE YOU ABLE TO DO ANYTHING TO GET AROUND THIS?

Discuss this with your local installer, as often they can build a clear Plexiglass wall between the top of the shower and the Showerdome, giving the required additional height.
